Annual Report

Academics

Learning gives creativity, certainty, and knowledge, and makes you great. The year 2025 commenced on a wonderful note when the results of the 10th and 12th class board exams came, and we are happy to share the details of the commendable performances of our students. The Class 12th result was declared, followed by Class 10th on 13th May, with outstanding performance of our students in both classes. Divyanshi Singh of Class 10th became the district topper of Prayagraj with 98.8% marks, followed by Akarshak Veer Singh with 98% and Kamodita with 96% marks. A part from this Satya Yadav, Akarshak Veer Singh & Akarsh Veer Singh scored hundred out of hundred in science as well as Information Technology. Divyanshi Singh, Mansi Patel & Shivendra Srivastava scored hundred out of hundred in Information Technology as well and set an example for the forth coming batches. 26 students scored 90% and above marks.

Class 12th results were satisfactory too with Ayushi Mishra becoming the topper of the school with 95.4% (Commerce). 12 students scored 90% and above marks. Vishal Kumar, a Computer Genius scored hundred out of hundred in computer science and set a remarkable example for others to follow.

None of these achievements would have been possible without the single-minded commitment and dedicated efforts of our teachers. We are also constantly encouraged by parents and well-wishers who have shown much confidence and given full support. I wish to acknowledge the efforts and guidance of our management, as their collaboration and contribution have made a big difference.

We are still not satisfied with this result. We are aiming for the No. 1 slot and have adopted various measures to achieve our goals. Extra class arrangements for the board examinees, regular tests, and special counseling sessions for children are some of these steps.

Sports

Sports, games, and physical fitness occupy a place of importance in our curriculum. Our students actively participate in both indoor and outdoor games and have a proven track record of achievements.

Utkarsh Maurya won district bronze medal in boxing at Vishnu Bhagwan Public School and also participated at zonal level at Varanasi. Arpit Chaudhary became first junior boxing state championship (2025) and bagged a bronzed medal. He also won CBSE Zonal Boxing Championship (2023) held in Jharkhand by a winning a gold medal followed by another gold medal in Varanasi in the year 2024. He also

represented his school in National Boxing Championship 2024 held in Haryana and bagged a Bronzed Medal. He also won a Silver Medal in Pryagraj District Boxing Championship 2024.

Another boxer Sanskar Agrawal represented the school and won several medals in district and state level events. He had been a bronzed medalist in Gurukul Montesory School, CBSE state bronze medalist in Tata Nagar Jamshedpur, Silver medalist at district level and silver medalist in CBSE state level events. He has also represented the school in National Level Boxing Championship.
